We are thrilled to inform you that your child has been selected to attend a trip to the Houses of Parliament in London on Tuesday 27th September 22. We have selected our Pupil Leadership Team to attend including Head Boy and Girl, Deputy Head Boy and Girl and Year 6 Prefects as a way of showing our appreciation for their support and to give them an understanding of how democracy works. The children will be travelling to London via the school minibus which will leave Park Lane at 7:45am prompt, therefore we ask that children arrive at school for 7:30am on this day. We aim to return to school by 6pm and as usual, if there are any delays with our return to school, we will inform you via our usual communication platforms.

As a part of the trip, the children will be given a tour of the Palace of Westminster and will attend a workshop relating to 'Campaigning and Parliament' run by Houses of Parliament staff.

Please can we kindly ask that children are sent into school in full school uniform on this day. They will need to bring a packed lunch or request a blue bag on the Google form attached. Due to the length of the trip, please can we ask that children have appropriate snacks to enjoy throughout the day as lunch will be enjoyed a little later due to the timing of the itinerary provided. The Google form attached will need to be completed by Monday 26th September to give permission for your child to attend the trip. We send our apologies for the lack of notice; however, the trip was originally cancelled because of the proposed train strikes which have now been postponed. Last year's Pupil Leadership Team went on this trip and thoroughly enjoyed the experience and learned so much that we felt that the opportunity was too good an experience for our Griffins to miss.
