

RE: Update to Co-Curricular Clubs – Spring Term

Dear Park Lane Family,

As part of our ongoing commitment to enhancing our co-curricular programme, and in response to the valuable feedback received from our families, we are writing to share some important updates to our club provision.

We are excited to introduce a range of new clubs that cater to a wide variety of interests, and we are confident there is something to engage every student. We encourage you to read the club blurbs carefully, as they provide further details about the activities and intended outcomes. All clubs are free of charge, and several are fully funded to further enhance what we can offer to our school community.

We have updated our sign-up process and will now be using Arbor for all club registrations. Please follow the steps outlined in the link provided to register your child's interest. Further support on how to complete the process can also be found in the attached guidance. You can find this in the club section of the app and have to select each club manually for each child. This does not confirm your child's place in the club. Please wait further confirmation for places on Arbor the following week. Please only send your child to a club once you have received confirmation. The deadline for submissions is Sunday 11th January at midday.

Once submitted via Arbor and reviewed by the team, children will be allocated to specific club registers. If a club reaches full capacity, your child will be placed on a waiting list, and you will receive a message to confirm this. To ensure fair access for all pupils, if a child does not attend their club for two consecutive weeks, their place will be forfeited and offered to another child on the waiting list.

All Spring Term clubs will commence in the week beginning Monday 19th January and will conclude in the week commencing Monday 9th March. Clubs will run for a 7-week period. Please note that timings vary, so we kindly ask that you refer to the attached timetable for specific start times and collection points.

Thank you for your continued support as we strive to provide enriching, high-quality experiences for all of our Griffins. We look forward to an engaging and successful term of co-curricular activities.
